ORDINANCE NO. 1017, S-2025

ORDINANCE REPROGRAMMING SAVINGS FROM THE UNOBLIGATED 70% LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT FUND (LDRRMF) FOR FY 2025 IN THE SUM OF SIXTY TWO MILLION SIXTY THOUSAND PESOS (P62,060,000.00) TO AUGMENT OTHER LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT RELATED PROGRAMS, PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES (LDRRM-PPA) AND EXPENSES

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991 authorizes the City Mayor to initiate and maximize the generation of resources and revenues, and apply the same to the implementation of development plans, programs, objectives, and priorities. He or she shall prepare and submit to the Sanggunian for approval the executive and supplemental budgets of the city;

WHEREAS, the same Code also states that "(a)fter the local chief executive concerned shall have submitted the executive budget to the sanggunian, no ordinance providing for a supplemental budget shall be enacted, except when supported by funds actually available as certified by the local treasurer or by new revenue sources." Implied from that power to approve executive or supplemental budget is the power to reprogram funds or otherwise use savings to augment funds under the General Appropriation Ordinance, subject to existing laws, rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, Section 336 of the Local Government Code of 1991 and Article 454 (b) of its IRR allow the use of appropriated funds and savings to augment any item in the approved annual budget (AB), to wit:

"SEC. 336. Use of Appropriated Funds and Savings. - Funds shall be available exclusively for the specific purpose for which they have been appropriated. No ordinance shall be passed authorizing any transfer of appropriations from one item to another. However, the local chief executive or the presiding officer of the sanggunian concerned, may, by ordinance, be authorized to augment any item in the approved AB for their respective offices from savings in other items within the same expense class of their respective appropriations.

WHEREAS, Article 454 (b) of the IRR of the Code defines "savings" as referring to portions or balances of any programmed appropriation free from any obligation or encumbrance, still available after the satisfactory completion or the unavoidable discontinuance or abandonment of the work, activity or purpose for which the appropriation is authorized, or arising from unpaid compensation and related costs pertaining to vacant positions and leaves of absence without pay.

On the other hand, "augmentation" implies the existence in the budget of an item, project, activity or purpose with an appropriation which upon implementation or subsequent evaluation of needed resources is determined to be deficient;

WHEREAS, Item 3.0 of COA Circular No. 2012-002 reiterated the purposes of the LDRRMF, such as, but not limited to, pre-disaster preparedness programs, post-disaster activities, payment of insurance premiums on property and on personnel accident insurance, and relief and recovery programs in communities or areas stricken by disasters, calamities, epidemics or complex emergencies;

WHEREAS, Item 4.0 of NDRRMC-DBM-DILG MC No. 2013-1 provides, among others, that, "[t]he LDRRMF shall cover the thirty percent (30%) lump-sum allocation for Quick Response Fund (QRF) and the seventy percent (70%) allocation for disaster prevention and mitigation, preparedness, response, rehabilitation and recovery";

WHEREAS, the Mandaluyong DRRM Officer confirmed that the amount of Sixty Two Million Sixty Thousand Pesos (P62,060,000.00) remain unencumbered and unobligated from savings derived from programs, projects and activities under 70% Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF) for FY2025;

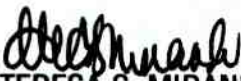
WHEREAS, there is a need to reprogram the said amount to immediately fund the site development of the fire affected areas of Blocks 27 and 29 in Barangay Addition Hills, provision for food subsistence, gasoline and other supplies to disaster victims as well as emergency preparedness and response teams, and repair and maintenance of disaster response vehicles and Emergency Operations Center;

WHEREAS, a Certification as to the availability of fund issued by the City Treasurer and a Certification as to the availability of appropriation/allotment issued by the City Accountant are attached herewith as Annexes "A" and "B", as well as the corresponding Certification of Actual Unobligated and Sources of Funds as Annex "C", and made integral parts hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Mandaluyong, in session assembled, APPROVES, the reprogramming of the savings from the unobligated 70% Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF) for FY 2025 in the sum of Sixty Two Million Sixty Thousand Pesos (P62,060,000.00) to augment other Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Related Programs, Projects and Activities (LDRRM-PPA) and expenses.
