ORDINANCE NO. 1037, S-2025

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING BIRTHDAY CASH GIFT INCENTIVES TO QUALIFIED SENIOR CITIZENS RESIDING IN THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG AMOUNTING TO (A) PHP3,000.00 UPON REACHING THE AGE OF 80 TO 84 YEARS OLD, (B) PHP5,000.00 UPON REACHING THE AGE OF 85 TO 89 YEARS OLD, THEREBY AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 809, S-2020 AND ALLOCATING FUNDS THEREFOR

WHEREAS, Article XV, Section 4, of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the family has the duty to take care for its elderly members but the State may also do so through just programs of social security;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of R.A. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that every local government unit shall exercise powers, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, the participation of senior citizens is invaluable to the growth of the City, as they pave the way for the new generation while maintaining the heritage and tradition of the City for the next ones to come;

WHEREAS, the City has, for numerous instances, granted incentives for senior citizens through legislative enactments granting financial incentives and non-monetary benefits and services;

WHEREAS, the City presently provides a Five Hundred Pesos (Php500.00) annual birthday cash gift by virtue of Ordinance No. 658, S-2017, as amended by Ordinance No. 809, S-2020, for qualified and registered senior citizens beginning their sixtieth (60th) birthday;

WHEREAS, as a tribute to the intangible contributions of our elderlies in the City, this City Council seeks to further incentivize our senior citizens in the City who have reached the ages of eighty (80) to eighty nine (89) and grant them additional cash gift to be given on the celebration of their birthday upon the presentation of the necessary documentary requirements to and verification by the Office of Senior Citizen Affairs (OSCA);

WHEREAS, the increase in the current cash gift being provided to senior citizens is justified due to their continuous participation in the programs and projects of the City geared towards societal growth and development and the City's intent to aid and assist them in defraying their costs and expenses in maintaining their health and wellness.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, as it is hereby ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong, in session duly assembled:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 809, S-2020 is hereby amended and read as follows:

“SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 658, S-2017 is hereby amended to increase the amount of the birthday cash gift of all the resident and registered senior citizens of the City of Mandaluyong, to read as follows:

“SECTION 1. CASH GIFT – All resident and registered senior citizens in the City of Mandaluyong shall be granted a yearly birthday cash gift in the amount of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00).

For senior citizens who reach the ages of eighty (80) to eighty-four (84) years old, they shall receive the amount of Three Thousand Pesos (P3,000.00), and for those who reach the ages of eighty-five (85) to eighty-nine (89) years old, they shall receive Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00).”

SECTION 2. The passage of this Ordinance automatically cancels the entitlement of qualified senior citizens within the above-stated age ranges to the FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (Php500.00) birthday cash gift given under Ordinance No. 809, S-2020.

In lieu thereof, the corresponding Birthday Cash Gift Incentives under this Ordinance, upon the submission of the documentary requirements and the conduct of the necessary verification procedures provided for under applicable ordinances, shall be given.

SECTION 3. During the initial year of the implementation of this Ordinance, the source of funds to cover the increase in the grant to qualified beneficiaries shall be taken from the available funds of the Office for Senior Citizens Affairs (OSCA) of Mandaluyong City, and subsequently the amount necessary to implement the Ordinance shall be included in the annual Appropriations Ordinance.

SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – Any provision or portion of this Ordinance found to be violative of the Constitution or invalid shall not impair the other provisions or parts thereof which shall continue to be in force and in effect.

SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE – Ordinances, rules, and regulations or parts thereof, which are inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE – This Ordinance shall take upon approval.




