ORDINANCE NO. 410, S-2008

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING STRICT COMPLIANCE AMONG HEALTH
PRACTITIONERS IN GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE FACILITIES
TO THE NATIONAL TUBERCULOSIS PROGRAM IN THE
CITY OF MANDALUYONG AND SUSTAINABILITY
OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE INITIATED MIXED DOTS

BE IT ENACTED, as it is hereby enacted, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong, by virtue of the powers vested in it by law, in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. The Local Government of Mandaluyong thru the City Health Office shall:

- I. Adopt and sustain the Private–Public Mix DOTS (PPMD) partners, as strategy to control Tuberculosis.
- II. Develop a local plan in consultation with PPMD.
- III. Facilitate the hiring of a pulmonologist for the Tuberculosis Diagnostic Committee.
- IV. Organize and implement advocacy activities and alert in communities.
- V. Implement the program according to the plans.
- VI. Designate a Medical NTP coordinator and staff such as nurses and medical technologists. Ensure other human resources such as doctors, public health nurses, health midwives and barangay health workers at the LGU level.
- VII. Prepare, submit and analyze quarterly reports.
- VIII. Implement a standardized quality assurance system for laboratory.
- IX. Adopt and implement the basic NTP diagnostic policy and standardized chemotherapy of TB.
- X. Monitor strict adherence to the standard protocol prescribed by the DOH among government and private facilities health practitioners when treating patients with tuberculosis.

SECTION 2. The Local Government of Mandaluyong, thru the City Health Office, shall assume responsibility for executing this project in the target areas specified in Clause I following NTP policy outlined in the Manual of Operations of the NTP 2001.

- i. Diagnosis
- ii. Treatments, including Direct Observation of Therapy
- iii. Drug Supply and Consumables
- iv. Monitoring and Supervision

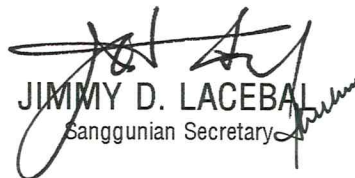
SECTION 3. The Local Government of Mandaluyong shall allocate an appropriate funding for the total implementation of the same project all throughout the year.

SECTION 4. All private health practitioners doing business in the City of Mandaluyong are hereby obliged to attend the yearly symposium/workshop relative to NTP PPMD on a schedule upon invitation by the City Health Office free of charge as budget for the said purpose has been allocated as mentioned in the preceding section.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its approval and publication at least once in a newspaper of general circulation in Metro Manila.

ENACTED on this 1st day of September, 2008 in the City of Mandaluyong.

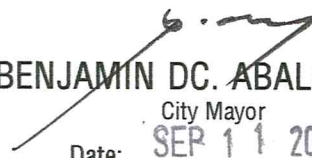

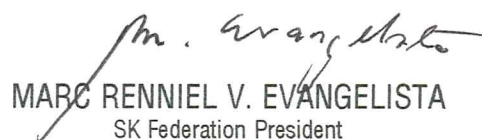
