ORDINANCE NO. 892, S-2022

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE XXIV (VEHICULAR VOLUME REDUCTION SCHEME), SECTIONS 166 AND 168 OF ORDINANCE NO. 743, S-2019, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "OMNIBUS TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT CODE OF THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG"

WHEREAS, on October 3, 2019, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong enacted City Ordinance No. 743, S-2019 entitled "Omnibus Traffic Management Code of the City of Mandaluyong";

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA), through MMDA Resolution No. 22-14 Series of 2022, started the reimplementation of the Unified Vehicular Volume Reduction Program (UVVRP) or number coding scheme in the National Capital Region (NCR) on August 15, 2022 from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on weekdays except holidays;

WHEREAS, the reimplementation of the number coding scheme in the NCR will reduce traffic volume by twenty percent (20%) during the morning and afternoon/evening peak hours;

WHEREAS, exempted from the said UVVRP are public utility vehicles (including tricycles), transport network vehicle services, motorcycles, garbage trucks, fuel trucks, marked government vehicles, trucks, ambulances, marked media vehicles, vehicles carrying essential and/or perishable goods;

WHEREAS, there is a need to amend Sections 166 and 168 of Article XXIV of Ordinance No. 743, S-2019 or the Omnibus Traffic Management Code of the City of Mandaluyong to suit to the approved Metro Manila Council Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, as it is hereby ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong City, in session duly assembled:

SECTION 1. Section 166, Article XXIV of Ordinance No. 743, S-2019, or the Omnibus Traffic Management Code of the City of Mandaluyong is hereby amended to read as follows:

> Section 166. PROHIBITED LICENSE PLATE ENDING. All motor vehicles, both public and private, with license plate ending as shown in the succeeding schedule hereof shall be prohibited except Saturday, Sunday and Holiday from operating in all national or city roads within the jurisdiction of the City of Mandaluyong from Seven o'clock in the morning (7:00 AM) up to Ten o'clock in the morning (10:00 AM) and from Five o'clock in the afternoon (5:00 PM) up to Eight o'clock in the evening (8:00 PM). In the absence of a license plate, the last numerical digit of the conduction sticker shall be the basis of prohibition.

SECTION 2. Section 168, Article XXIV of Ordinance No. 743, S-2019, or the Omnibus Traffic Management Code of the City of Mandaluyong is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 168. EXEMPTED VEHICLES. Only the following vehicles are considered automatically exempted:

- a. Motorcycles;
- Ambulance, fire trucks, police patrol, military vehicles on official functions;
- c. Diplomatic vehicles with diplomatic plates;
- d. Government vehicles with government plates or appropriate LTO stickers or marking expressly showing the name of the agency or office while in official use:
- e. Official media vehicles with marking expressly showing their company while in official use:
- f. Tow trucks duly accredited by the City of Mandaluyong;
- g. Vehicles used by medical practitioners in an emergency:
- Vehicles either driven by a Senior Citizen or PWDs or is a passenger;
- Tricycles;
- transport network vehicle services;
- k. garbage trucks;
- I. fuel trucks; and
- m. vehicles carrying essential and/or perishable goods.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances and Resolutions or any part thereof which are inconsistent with the foregoing provisions are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect after its approval and publication at least once in a newspaper of general circulation in Metro Manila.

SECTION 5. Let copy of this Ordinance be furnished the Metro Manila Development Authority, Office of the City Mayor, Mandaluyong City Police Station, Liga ng mga Barangay, City Traffic and Parking Management Department, City Ordinance and Enforcement Division, Anti-Vice Division, Public Order and Safety Division, Tricycle Regulatory Office, and other offices concerned for their information, guidance and reference.
