A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR BENJAMIN S. ABALOS TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (INSTITUTIONAL PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM) BETWEEN THE PHILIPPINE CHARITY SWEEPSTAKES OFFICE (PCSO) AND THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF MANDALUYONG AND OTHER RELATED DOCUMENTS AND TO REPRESENT THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF MANDALUYONG TO RECEIVE THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AMOUNTING TO TEN MILLION PESOS (PHP10,000,000.00)

WHEREAS, the PCSO is the principal government agency tasked to raise and provide funds for health programs, medical assistance and services, and other charities of national character;

WHEREAS, in furtherance of its mandate, PCSO established the Institutional Partnership Program (IPP) to augment the resources of DSWD registered and accredited social work agencies through the provision of funding assistance, for the implementation of the latter's health programs and services for the disadvantaged sectors in local communities;

WHEREAS, the CITY GOVERNMENT OF MANDALUYONG is a Local Government Unit, which, through its CITY SOCIAL WELFARE DEVELOPEMNT DEPARTMENT (CSWDD) provides Financial and Medical Assistance, Emergency Assistance Program, Supplemental Feeding Day Care Services, Women Welfare Program, Family Welfare Program, Child and Youth Welfare Program, OFW, former rebels, etc.; Indirect Programs, Capability building, research, advocacy, etc;

WHEREAS, the CITY GOVERNMENT OF MANDALUYONG, through its CSWDD, will comply and submit the documentary requirements or application of the Institutional Partnership Program with the PCSO;

WHEREAS, the PCSO will evaluate the application of the CITY GOVERNMENT OF MANDALUYONG, through its PCSO Charity Sector to determine whether the CITY GOVERNMENT OF MANDALUYONG is eligible for the financial assistance and will recommend it as one of the PCSO's institutional partners under the IPP for Calendar Year (CY) 2021;

WHEREAS, consistent with its mandate, the PCSO, through its Board of Directors, approved under Board Resolution No. 0149, Series of 2021 the amount of TEN MILLION PESOS (Php10,000,000.00) as financial assistance under the IPP for CY 2021 of the CSWD chargeable against the Charity Fund, subject to the availability of funds and applicable accounting and auditing rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, the designation of beneficiary was changed to the CITY GOVERNMENT OF MANDALUYONG per approval of the Vice Chairperson and General Manager pursuant to Board Resolution No. 0088, Series of 2022;




