RESOLUTION NO. 3154, S-2022

A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THAT HONORABLE CITY MAYOR BENJAMIN S. ABALOS SIGN AND ENTER INTO A SISTERHOOD AND TWINNING NEGOTIATION AND AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TANAUAN, LEYTE AND THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG

WHEREAS, Municipality of Tanauan is a 2nd class municipality in the province of Leyte. According to the 2020 census, the Municipality holds a number of 54 Barangays with a population of 57,455 people. It has a total land area of 78.41 km. It is also one of the oldest towns in Leyte dating back to the year of 1710;

WHEREAS, Municipality of Tanauan is one of the adopted municipalities of the City of Mandaluyong, from among the LGUs severely affected by super Typhoon Yolanda on November 8, 2013;

WHEREAS, the people of the Municipality of Tanauan, Leyte represented by its Honorable Mayor Ma. Gina E. Merilo, through Tanauan, Leyte Resolution No. 2022-183 expressed manifestation of the Municipality's strong desire to establish a sisterhood-community relation and town twinning agreement with the City of Mandaluyong, wherein the sisterhood relation may yield knowledge from each other's better practices with regard to local governance where the establishment of strategic business links will eventually lead to the promotion of general welfare;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Tanauan, Leyte firmly believes that forging ties with the City of Mandaluyong would pave way for the Municipality of Tanauan for economic development, share/exchange knowledge in technology, tourism, culture and arts, planning and development, commerce, trade and industry, youth education and sports, environmental protection, public health and social services. With the City of Mandaluyong's success in commerce, industry, and civic programs and projects that are advantageous for the Municipality of Tanauan, the sisterhood agreement will alleviate the living conditions of its constituents in terms of technical and financial assistance;

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) supports the sisterhood or town-twinning programs as expressed in the DILG Memorandum Circular No. 97306;

WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong hereby endorses to the Honorable City Mayor BENJAMIN S. ABALOS to accept the intention of the Municipality of Tanauan, Leyte to establish a sisterhood community-relations with the City of Mandaluyong.



ADOPTED on this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of August 2022, in the City of Mandaluyong.


