RESOLUTION NO. 3157, S-2022

A RESOLUTION REITERATING THE OBJECTIVES OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8491, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE FLAG AND HERALDIC CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES, AND URGING ALL BUSINESS AND COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS, GOVERNMENT INSTITUTIONS, NON-GOVERNMENT OFFICES, AND OTHER HISTORICAL LANDMARKS IN THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG TO DISPLAY, HANG, OR HOIST BOTH THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL FLAG AND THE FLAG OF THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG THROUGHOUT THE YEAR TO INSTILL AND STRENGTHEN PATRIOTISM AND NATIONALISM AMONG THE CONSTITUENTS OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, Section 13, Article II of the 1987 Constitution recognizes the role of the State in inculcating patriotism and nationalism in every citizen;

WHEREAS, in our country, national symbols like national flag, national anthem, motto, and coat-of-arms and other heraldic items and devices are regarded as concrete and definite representations of the Philippines and its People;

WHEREAS, as one of the most glaring depictions of the country, the Philippine flag's history stems from our fight for freedom and independence, and thus, is a visible reminder of the sacrifices of our heroes and forefathers, and as its People, our shared dreams, ideals, traditions, and aspirations;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 8491 also known as "The Flag and Heraldic Code of the Philippines" espouses the importance of complying, abiding, and conforming to the standard means of nationalistic expression as prescribed by law, according and promoting the highest sense of reverence and respect to the same being the embodiment of the Filipino people and an expression of our sovereignty and national solidarity;

WHEREAS, Section 7 of R.A. 8491 provides that the flag may also be displayed throughout the year in private buildings or offices or raised in the open on flag-staffs in front of private buildings;

WHEREAS, His Excellency President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr., in his Independence Day statement, urged homes, government offices, and business establishments to display the Philippine flag at all times;

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Benjamin S. Abalos, in his inaugural address to the City Council and in his speech during the "29 de Agosto" or "Unang Sigaw ng Himagsikan" celebration, also urged the City Council to enact measures requesting all establishments, government institutions, and non-governmental offices within the City of Mandaluyong, as well as historical landmarks and major thoroughfares within the bounds of the City, to display, hang, or hoist both the Philippine flag and the City of Mandaluyong flag throughout the year to rekindle the spirit of nationalism and inculcate in the minds of the people of Mandaluyong a sense of pride in and respect to their motherland;

WHEREAS, the City of Mandaluyong is, likewise, represented by its City Flag, comprising of figurative elements identifying the City of Mandaluyong and its constituents;

WHEREAS, as a progressive component of the Republic, it is incumbent upon the constituents of the City of Mandaluyong to be good examples of nationalistic and socially-responsible citizens, and as a manifestation of the same, it is, thus, fitting that respect to the Philippine flag and the flag of the City of Mandaluyong, including the proper display and hoisting of the flag when flown from the flagpole when the flag is publicly displayed, be accorded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED by the Sangguniang Panlungsod, reiterating the objectives of Republic Act No. 8491 otherwise known as The Flag and Heraldic Code of the Philippines, instilling, and strengthening patriotism and nationalism and urging all business and commercial establishments, government institutions, non-government offices and other historical landmarks in the City of Mandaluyong to display, hang or fly both the Philippine national flag and the flag of the City of Mandaluyong throughout the year.

FURTHER RESOLVED, as it hereby RESOLVES that the display of the Philippine flag as encouraged in the previously preceding paragraph shall be undertaken in compliance with the provisions of Republic Act No. 8491.

FURTHERMORE RESOLVED, that in furtherance of the objectives of R.A. 8491, the Philippine flag must at all times be treated with utmost care, with protective measures being resorted to in order to maintain its sanctity. In this view, the protection of the flags' physical condition must be prioritized at all times. The same restrictions and prohibitions shall, likewise, be imposed upon the display of the flag of the City of Mandaluyong which shall be made available upon request from the Cultural Department, City Government of Mandaluyong.

FURTHERMORE RESOLVED, that a Philippine flag, when worn out or disfigured by causes independent of human action or intervention, shall be disposed of in compliance with the relevant provisions of the law relating to the same.



FURTHERMORE RESOLVED, that the display of the Philippine flag, when applicable, shall be subject to the prohibitions provided for under Section 34 of R.A. No. 8491, and shall not be imposed upon buildings occupied by aliens and foreign nationals, offices of embassies, diplomatic establishments, and international organizations, as well as in establishments promoting frivolity, hilarity, and boisterous merriment and recreation. The same restrictions and prohibitions shall, likewise, be imposed upon the display of the flag of the City of Mandaluyong.

FINALLY RESOLVED, that the display of both flags be undertaken in a manner which puts forth the flags as representations of the country, the City of Mandaluyong, and its People, and as such, shall not be in any way be casted dishonor or be ridiculed upon.

ADOPTED on this 13th day of September 2022, in the City of Mandaluyong.


