RESOLUTION NO. 3190, S-2022

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A FIVE-YEAR CONTRACT FOR THE SUPPLY, DELIVERY, INSTALLATION, & CONFIGURATION OF UNIFIED COMMUNICATION (UC), TRUNKS AND INTERNET, CCTV, PA-BGM AND STRUCTURED CABLING, INCLUDING MANAGEMENT, MAINTENANCE AND SUPPORT SERVICES THEREOF, AT MANDALUYONG CITY MEDICAL CENTER (MCMC) LOCATED AT MARTINEZ STREET, BARANGAY ADDITION HILLS, MANDALUYONG CITY, FOR THE FULL PROJECT COST AND PRIORITIZE THE INCLUSION OF THE AMOUNT PROGRAMMED IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET PROPOSAL FOR YEAR COVERED

WHEREAS, deeply committed in serving all constituents, the City of Mandaluyong desires to provide the Mandaleños with another tertiary hospital that will be accessible and responsive to their health care needs;

WHEREAS, to this end, the City of Mandaluyong shall enter into a five-year contract for the Supply, Delivery, Installation, & Configuration of Unified Communication (UC), Trunks and Internet, CCTV, PA-BGM and Structured Cabling, including Management, Maintenance and Support Services for MCMC with a single contractor chosen after competitive bidding;

WHEREAS, in order for national government agencies to enter into multi-year contract, a Multi-year Obligational Authority (MYOA) is issued by the DBM in accordance with existing circulars, rules and regulations. However, it does not cover multi-year projects entered by local government units such as the City of Mandaluyong;

WHEREAS, akin to a MYOA issued by the DBM, it is important that prior to a competitive bidding a similar authority be issued by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong in order to give priority the inclusion in the annual budgetary requirements of the City Government the amount programmed to cover the obligations for the multi-year project and be duly covered by the annual appropriations ordinances;

WHEREAS, the Head of Procuring Entity (HoPE) certifies that procurement activity pertaining to the multi-year project to be covered by such authority from the Sangguniang Panlungsod has not been started as of date of request;

WHEREAS, the HoPE confirms their commitment to give priority and include the annual budgetary requirements of the above-mentioned project as specified in ANNEX "A" in the City Government's annual budget proposals for the ensuing years.

NOW THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong, in session assembled, RESOLVED, as it hereby RESOLVES to allow the City of Mandaluyong to appropriate funds for a Five-Year Contract for the Supply, Delivery, Installation & Configuration of Unified Communication (UC), Trunks and Internet, CCTV, PA-BGM and Structured Cabling, including Management, Maintenance and Support Services thereof for Mandaluyong City Medical Center (MCMC) located at Martinez Street, Barangay Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City, for the full project cost and prioritize the inclusion of the amount programmed in the annual budget proposal for the year covered as indicated in Annex "A" hereof.

RESOLVED, notwithstanding the issuance of this Authority, the multi-year contract to be entered shall be guided by the following:

1. The liability of the City of Mandaluyong for a given year shall only be limited to the available appropriations for the purpose for a specific year;
2. Obligations to be incurred by the City of Mandaluyong in any given Calendar Year shall in no case exceed the allotment released for the purpose;
3. Annual review shall be conducted by the City of Mandaluyong as part of the process to enable to negotiate for a lower price for the service in the event that the actual cost for the good or service covered by the contract become lower as per prevailing market analysis; and
4. The authority thus given may be amended if the multi-year contract is adjusted as a result of the annual review conducted.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, let a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Commission on Audit-Mandaluyong, the Office of the City Mayor, BAC Chairperson, City Accountant, City Treasurer, City Planning and Development Coordinator and MCMC Hospital Director for their information and guidance.

ADOPTED on this 8th day of November 2022, in the City of Mandaluyong.





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
