RESOLUTION NO. 3191, S-2022

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR BENJAMIN S. ABALOS TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE COMMISSION ON POPULATION AND DEVELOPMENT – NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION (POPCOM-NCR) RELATIVE TO THE PHILIPPINE DEVELOPMENT PLAN 2017-2022 AND THE FULL IMPLEMENTATION OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10354 OR THE RESPONSIBLE PARENTHOOD AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH ACT OF 2012

WHEREAS, the Commission on Population and Development – National Capital Region (POPCOM-NCR) is a government department duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines principally tasked with the development and implementation of population-related programs and strategies in pursuit of socioeconomic development.

WHEREAS, the City Government of Mandaluyong has agreed to implement health sector reforms consistent with the Philippine Development Plan of 2017-2022 and leading to the full implementation of Republic Act No. 10354 or the Responsible Parenthood and Reproductive Health Act of 2012.

WHEREAS, the City Government of Mandaluyong has, likewise, agreed to implement the National Government’s National Program on Population and Family Planning (NPPFP), which requires the designation or appointment of Local Population Officers and the mobilization of all its local offices, for the implementation of the NPPFP at the community level.

WHEREAS, the POPCOM-NCR shall thereby act as institutional co-managers, as well as provide technical support, in the implementation of the NPPFP alongside the City Government of Mandaluyong.

WHEREAS, a Memorandum of Agreement has been drafted to cover this partnership between the City Government of Mandaluyong and the Commission on Population and Development – National Capital Region.

WHEREAS, relative thereto, the City Legal Department reviewed the draft Memorandum of Agreement that will govern the parties’ complementary rights and obligations, and the same has been found to be reasonably and properly crafted and in accordance with law.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong, in session assembled, RESOLVED, as it hereby RESOLVES, to authorize the Honorable City Mayor BENJAMIN S. ABALOS to enter into and sign the Memorandum of Agreement with the Commission on Population and Development – National Capital Region (POPCOM-NCR) relative to the Philippine Development Plan 2017-2022 and the full implementation of Republic Act No. 10354 or The Responsible Parenthood and Reproductive Health Act of 2012.






