RESOLUTION NO. 3471, S-2024

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE
PHILIPPINE PLAN OF ACTION FOR
NUTRITION (PPAN) 2023 – 2028**

WHEREAS, the existing programs by the National Government dedicated to nutrition span across all levels of governance, including the substantial participation of local government units across the country;

WHEREAS, despite this, the prevalent concerns on malnutrition in the country still necessitate the involvement and participation of the people at the grassroots level, particularly the barangays;

WHEREAS, to address this, the National Nutrition Council (NNC), along with numerous stakeholders, formulated and approved the Philippine Plan of Action for Nutrition (PPAN) 2023 – 2028 on 12 July 2023, determined as the country's overall framework for nutrition action to be achieved through a strategic, multi-sectoral, multi-level, and directional approach;

WHEREAS, under the PPAN 2023 – 2028 and Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) Memorandum Circular No. 2024-071, local government units play a crucial role in the realization of the PPAN 2023 – 2028;

WHEREAS, as provided by the Plan, all LGUs are tasked to:

- Organize, reorganize, and strengthen functional Local Nutrition Committees at the Provincial, City/Municipal, and Barangay level with the local chief executive as chairperson through an enactment of a local ordinance that entails permanency;
- Designate a Nutrition Action Officer, on a full-time basis and preferably in a plantilla position, with the corresponding staff support to coordinate nutrition action and implement one or more components of the local nutrition action plan as may be needed;
- Include in their respective Local Development Plans and Annual Investment Programs (AIP), applicable PPAN programs to ensure adequate funding for nutrition impact;
- Ensure the formulation, or if existing, revision/updating of the local nutrition action plan to include programs, projects, and activities that converge in families of nutritionally vulnerable individuals (a pregnant woman, lactating woman, children 0-23 months old, or a malnourished child under 5 years of age) as well as communities/barangays with high levels of malnutrition across all life stages;
- Implement, monitor, and evaluate their respective local nutrition action plans;
- Monitor and evaluate the local nutrition action plan in accordance with the MELLPI Pro Guidelines;

- Recognize the outstanding LGU performers in local nutrition program implementation and local nutrition focal points in performance of their nutrition program management functions based on MELLPI Pro results;
- Determine functionality of the Local Nutrition Committee using the MELLPI Pro LGU Tool Worksheet on the Local Nutrition Committee;
- Conduct the Plan Implementation Review to assess the Local Nutrition Action Plan of the current year at the last quarter for use during the preparation of the Local Nutrition Action Plan for the following year;
- Sustain recruitment and deployment of community-based nutrition volunteers or barangay nutrition scholars, at least one (1) per barangay, and continually support them through capability building, logistics provision such as weighing scale and height boards, and monetary and non-monetary incentives;
- Recognize barangays and members of the local nutrition committee in their excellent implementation of nutrition programs;
- Develop and implement programs that will ensure good nutrition among its employees in partnership with professional organizations of nutritionists-dietitians;
- Pass/enact local policies to support the implementation of PPAN;
- Ensure community participation by engaging civil society organizations (CSOs), the private sector, and other stakeholders in the planning and implementation of nutrition programs;
- Conduct of Regular Plan Implementation Review ideally annually especially when the results of the annual Operation Timbang Plus are available for identification and implementation of needed adjustments in the local nutrition program; and
- Submit semestral reports based on the submitted and approved LNAPs with corresponding means of verification (MOVs).

WHEREAS, the PPAN 2023 – 2028 proves to be consistent with the thrust of the City of Mandaluyong and its Local Nutrition Committee as regards the aspect of nutrition, as the City joins the National Government in the implementation of the PPAN 2023 – 2028 and intends to adopt the same for the betterment of all Mandalenyos.

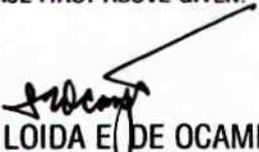
NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong, in session assembled, RESOLVED, as it hereby RESOLVES, to adopt the Philippine Plan of Action for Nutrition (PPAN) 2023 – 2028.

RESOLVED FURTHER, the City Nutrition Office shall spearhead the City's efforts to comply with and perform its necessary duties and responsibilities under the PPAN 2023 – 2028;

RESOLVED FINALLY, that the necessary funding is hereby allotted or appropriated to shoulder the costs or expenses that may be incurred subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
