RESOLUTION NO. 3473, S-2024

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE NATIONAL
POLICY ON NUTRITION IN EMERGENCIES (NiE)
AS ADOPTED BY THE NATIONAL NUTRITION
COUNCIL GOVERNING BOARD**

WHEREAS, Article XIII, Section 11 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution enshrines the duty of the State to make health and social services readily available for Filipinos;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991, local government units are mandated to promote the health and safety of its constituents, while exercising powers and discharging functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, and incidental to the efficient and effective provision of health services;

WHEREAS, emergencies and disasters often reveal the weaknesses of established systems in any locality while putting the general public at risk of developing health conditions;

WHEREAS, notwithstanding the efforts of the National Government and local government units to provide a thorough mechanism to address the instability of food and nutrition through the devising of relevant plans, the influx of disasters and calamities in the country make these interventions vulnerable to immediate occurrences;

WHEREAS, to address the matter, the National Nutrition Council (NNC) Governing Board approved Resolution No. 1, S-2009 on 03 December 2009, adopting the National Policy on Nutrition Management in Emergencies and Disasters, and thereafter, on April 2008, Resolution No. 2, S-2008, adopting the Strategic Plan on Nutrition in Emergencies (NiE) for 2017-2022;

WHEREAS, to keep these policies updated, several changes and developments have led to their review and updating of the National Policy on Nutrition Management in Emergencies and Disaster in 2019 and 2021, leading to its repeal and the adoption of an updated National Policy on Nutrition in Emergencies;

WHEREAS, to address this, the Philippine Integrated Management of Acute Malnutrition (PIMAM) was contextualized and adopted, with the Department of Health issuing Administrative Order No. 2015-0055 on the National Guidelines on the Management of Acute Malnutrition for Children under 5 years;

WHEREAS, through the NNC Governing Board Resolution No. 02, S-2022, the NNC Governing Board adopted the National Policy on Nutrition in Emergencies;

WHEREAS, as a partner in nation-building, the City of Mandaluyong aims to promote the general welfare and health of its constituents, particularly the need for the establishment of standards and guidelines on appropriate nutrition interventions, the identification of agency involvement for a robust and effective nutrition planning and evaluation, and the preparation and management of food and nutrition situation in times of emergencies and disasters;

WHEREAS, considering the important role on nutrition in disaster risk and management, the City of Mandaluyong intends to adopt the National Policy on Nutrition in Emergencies as adopted by the National Nutrition Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong, in session assembled, RESOLVED, as it hereby RESOLVES, to adopt the National Policy on Nutrition in Emergencies.

RESOLVED FURTHER, continuous and consistent implementation, monitoring, and evaluation of the said Project is likewise directed to the appropriate offices of the City Government of Mandaluyong;

RESOLVED FINALLY, that the necessary funding is hereby allotted or appropriated to shoulder the costs or expenses that may be incurred subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

ADOPTED on this 12th day of July 2024, in the City of Mandaluyong.
