**RESOLUTION NO. 3474, S-2024**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE PHILIPPINE INTEGRATED MANAGEMENT OF ACUTE MALNUTRITION (PIMAM) AND THE NATIONAL GUIDELINES ON THE MANAGEMENT OF ACUTE MALNUTRITION FOR CHILDREN UNDER FIVE (5) YEARS OF AGE**

WHEREAS, Article XIII, Section 11 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution enshrines the duty of the State to make health and social services readily available for Filipinos;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991, local government units are mandated to promote the health and safety of its constituents, while exercising powers and discharging functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, and incidental to the efficient and effective provision of health services;

WHEREAS, the Department of Health, as the lead agency of the State focused on the promotion of health programs for all Filipinos, considers the physical growth of children, particularly those of age zero (0) to seventy-one (71) months, as a parameter to determining whether children are afforded good nutrition and health well-being;

WHEREAS, the persistence of nutrition issues impacting the survival and long-term development of children, especially those under five (5) years of age, has been a long-standing problem in the country, giving rise to the concept of acute malnutrition or "wasting" – a life-threatening form of malnutrition;

WHEREAS, to address this, the Philippine Integrated Management of Acute Malnutrition (PIMAM) was contextualized and adopted, with the Department of Health issuing Administrative Order No. 2015-0055 on the National Guidelines on the Management of Acute Malnutrition for Children under 5 years;

WHEREAS, the National Guidelines on the Management of Acute Malnutrition for Children under 5 years seeks to provide the policy, strategy, and standards to health, nutrition, and social service providers, including government partners, civil society organizations, and donors involved in the effective and efficient implementation of the PIMAM;

WHEREAS, under the same Guidelines, local government units are responsible to enhance the capacities of their communities to identify, refer, and manage cases of acute malnutrition and implement mechanisms, tools, and systems for supplies management and monitoring and evaluation of service delivery during routine health programs and emergencies, among other responsibilities;

WHEREAS, as a partner in nation-building, the City of Mandaluyong aims to promote the general welfare and health of its constituents, particularly the younger members of the society and support the cultivation of their physical, mental, and psychological growth;

WHEREAS, considering the laudable objectives and effectiveness of the PIMAM in other localities in the country, the City of Mandaluyong intends to adopt the PIMAM and the National Guidelines on the Management of Acute Malnutrition for Children under 5 years issued by the DOH.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong, in session assembled, RESOLVED, as it hereby RESOLVES, to adopt the Philippine Integrated Management of Acute Malnutrition (PIMAM) and the National Guidelines on the Management of Acute Malnutrition for Children Under Five (5) Years of Age.


RESOLVED FURTHER, a Local PIMAM Management Team, headed by the City Health Officer, shall be created and responsible for the implementation of the Guidelines in the City of Mandaluyong;

RESOLVED FURTHER, continuous and consistent implementation, monitoring, and evaluation of the said Project is likewise directed to the appropriate offices of the City Government of Mandaluyong;

RESOLVED FINALLY, that the necessary funding is hereby allotted or appropriated to shoulder the costs or expenses that may be incurred subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

ADOPTED on this 12<sup>th</sup> day of July 2024, in the City of Mandaluyong.


