RESOLUTION OF COMMENDATION AND EXPRESSING THE PROFOUND SYMPATHY AND SINCERE CONDOLENCES OF THE 12TH COUNCIL ON THE DEATH OF ITS BELOVED CITY COUNCILOR, HONORABLE MICHAEL "MIKE" R. OCAMPO

WHEREAS, Hon. Michael R. Ocampo, "KONSI MIKE", dedicated public servant and exceptional leader, passed away on August 10, 2024, at the age of sixty six (66). Councilor "Mike", as he is fondly called by his peers, was born on March 17, 1958 to humble parents Santiago G. Ocampo and Lourdes R. Ocampo, as the second eldest of their six children. He has served the City Government of Mandaluyong from 1980 up to present (44 years), marking one of the longest tenures of public service in the history of our local government. He first served as a real property appraiser at the City Assessor's Department for almost 25 years from 1980-2004 and significantly contributed to the increase of the City's revenue from compulsory tax collections;

WHEREAS, in 2004, he was elected as City Councilor and earned the trust of Mandaleños where he was an independent candidate. The late Councilor served the people with dedication, integrity and distinction over a span of nine years;

WHEREAS, he became the Chairman of the Committee on Human Rights where he championed the rights of persons with disability, women and children. During his 2nd and 3rd terms, he was the Chairman of the Committee on Landed Estates, Peace & Order and Tricycle Franchising Board and genuinely dedicated tireless efforts to the Land for the Landless, Home for the Homeless program of the City;

WHEREAS, lauded for his exemplary performance and leadership, he also passionately and selflessly served as the Public Relations Officer IV at the Office of the Mayor after his nine-year term as City Councilor that ended in 2013;

WHEREAS, in 2022, after his son, former Councilor Fernando Ocampo finished his nine-year term, Councilor Mike decided to run again as City Councilor and won the heart of Mandaleños. He became one of the City Councilors (District 2) from 2022 up to present;

WHEREAS, throughout his 44 years of government service, Coun. Mike was a pillar of our City advocating for the well-being of our constituents. He was not just a colleague, but a friend to many people, mentor and leader who exemplified the true meaning of service;

WHEREAS, the passing of a dedicated and honorable public servant, Councilor Mike Ocampo is a profound loss to our City. Councilor Mike earned the respect and admiration of colleagues, constituents, and community at large leaving a lasting legacy of passion and commitment to public service;



ADOPTED on this 12th day of August 2024, in the City of Mandaluyong.


