RESOLUTION NO. 3510, S-2024

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR BENJAMIN S. ABALOS TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF MANDALUYONG AND THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE 14TH CYCLE OF THE SUPPLEMENTAL FEEDING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the state of nutrition in the Philippines has continued to be a pressing concern, with undernutrition and malnutrition being some of the most common and alarming problems faced by the Filipinos, thereby affecting the country's potential for development;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11037 or An Act Institutionalizing a National Feeding Program for Undernourished Children in Public Day Care, Kindergarten and Elementary Schools to Combat Hunger and Undernutrition Among Filipino Children and Appropriating Funds Therefor, aims for the State to establish a comprehensive national feeding program to address undernutrition among Filipino children in particular;

WHEREAS, Section 4(a) of the aforementioned Republic Act states that the DSWD, in coordination with the local government units, shall implement this feeding program for undernourished children aged three to five years old, which shall include the provision of at least one (1) fortified meal for a period of not less than one hundred twenty (120) days in a year;

WHEREAS, the Supplemental Feeding Program, the provision of food in addition to the regular meals for children between 2 to 4 years old enrolled in Child Development Centers (CDC) and Supervised Neighborhood Play (NSP) as part of the Department of Social Welfare and Development's (DSWD) contribution to the early childhood care and development program of the government;

WHEREAS, in the implementation of the 13th Cycle of the Supplemental Feeding Program, the City Government of Mandaluyong was able to cover 4,650 children enrolled in CDCs and NSPs areas which beneficially boosted the children's nutritional state;

WHEREAS, to further improve and expand the continuous provision and implementation of nutrition programs and services to the children of Mandaluyong, a Supplementary Feeding Program for the 14th Cycle is imperative, targeting 3,800 male and 3,200 female children enrolled in CDCs and SNP areas, to be more responsive to their nutritional needs, through the City Social Welfare and Development in accordance with the MOU that will be executed between the City Government and the DSWD-NCR;

WHEREAS, the budget allotted for the continuous implementation of this program will be sourced from the budget of the DSWD-NCR, pursuant to Section 11 of the said Republic Act, with an allotted budget of Php12,600,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, and upon motion duly seconded by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Mandaluyong, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Mandaluyong authorizes Honorable City Mayor Benjamin S. Abalos to sign a Memorandum of Understanding between the City Government of Mandaluyong and the Department of Social Welfare and Development for the implementation of the 14th Cycle of the Supplemental Feeding Program.

ADOPTED on this 23rd day of September 2024, in the City of Mandaluyong.
