RESOLUTION NO. 3678, S-2025

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE RECOMMENDED AMENDMENTS TO CERTAIN PROGRAMS, PROJECTS, AND ACTIVITIES (PPAs) IN THE CY 2025 PEACE AND ORDER AND PUBLIC SAFETY (POPS) PLAN OF THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 309 provides that the City Peace and Order Council (CPOC) is responsible for formulating plans and recommending measures to improve and enhance the peace and order situation within its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Section 5.4.2.4 of Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) Memorandum Circular No. 2019-143, otherwise known as the Omnibus Guidelines for Peace and Order Councils (POCs), states that one of the major functions of Local Peace and Order Councils (LPOCs) is to formulate a three-year Peace and Order and Public Safety (POPS) Plan, which shall be consistent with the Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP) and Annual Investment Plan (AIP);

WHEREAS, the Mandaluyong City Peace and Order Council (MCPOC) formulated its POPS Plan for CY 2023–2025 in September 2022 to address issues concerning peace and order and public safety in the City;

WHEREAS, due to the non-implementation of the majority of Programs, Projects, and Activities (PPAs) scheduled in the 1st semester of CY 2025 and the change of priorities of the concerned MCPOC member agencies, a Planning-Workshop was conducted on August 7–8, 2025 at Ciara's Events Place, Mandaluyong City, with the participation of the Technical Working Group (TWG);

WHEREAS, after comprehensive discussions and thorough deliberations during the said participatory workshop, the MCPOC-TWG recommended the reprogramming of selected PPAs for CY 2025, without altering the total allocation of each concerned office/agency, as summarized below:

Agency	Previous PPAs/Allocation	Revised PPAs/Allocation
PNP-Mandaluyong	9 PPAs — ₱4,440,000.00	10 PPAs — ₱4,440,000.00
BFP-Mandaluyong	9 PPAs — ₱3,900,000.00	4 PPAs — ₱3,900,000.00
POSD-CCASD	4 PPAs — ₱1,100,000.00	2 PPAs — ₱1,100,000.00

WHEREAS, during its regular meeting on September 3, 2025, the MCPOC, through majority vote of its members, approved the proposed reprogrammed PPAs for inclusion in the CY 2025 POPS Plan through **MCPOC Resolution No. 04-2025**;



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong, in session duly assembled, to ADOPT the recommended amendments to certain Programs, Projects and Activities (PPAs) in the CY 2025 Peace and Order and Public Safety (POPS) Plan of the City of Mandaluyong, as approved by the Mandaluyong City Peace and Order Council under Resolution No. 04-2025.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to the Mandaluyong City Peace and Order Council (MCPOC), the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), and all concerned agencies for their information, guidance, and appropriate action.

ADOPTED on this 24th day of September 2025, in the City of Mandaluyong.




