RESOLUTION NO. 3681, S-2025

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE  
MAYOR CARMELITA A. ABALOS TO ENTER INTO  
AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT  
AND OTHER RELATED AGREEMENTS WITH THE  
DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY (DOE) FOR THE  
IMPLEMENTATION OF THE "SOLAR SOLUTIONS  
FOR GOVERNMENT: ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND  
RENEWABLE ENERGY IN PUBLIC BUILDINGS"  
PROGRAM IN THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG**

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that, every local government unit shall exercise, among other powers, such other powers which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, energy efficiency and conservation are established measures to gauge a local government unit's progression in the efficient use of energy in its programs and projects, coupled with the development and utilization of efficient renewable energy technologies and systems seeking to sustain the already-established measures seeking to comprehensively approach the energy situation in the country;

WHEREAS, for this purpose, Republic Act No. 11285 or the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Act was enacted which, among others, established a framework for introducing and institutionalizing fundamental policies on energy efficiency and conservation;

WHEREAS, as provided for by law, local government units (LGUs) are mandated to establish their respective Energy Consumption and Conservation Report (ECCR) headed by an Energy Efficiency and Conservation Officer, develop and implement their respective Local Energy Efficiency and Conservation Plan and incorporate the same in their local development plans, and assist the Department of Energy in monitoring compliance;

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) issued Memorandum Circular (MC) No. 2020-082, as reiterated by DILG MC No. 2025-047, to continuously implement the law and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) in the local level, including the implementation of the Government Energy Management Program (GEMP) and the execution and procurement of energy efficient projects in LGUs;

WHEREAS, in line with the spirit of the law, the Department of Energy (DOE) initiated the Solar Solutions for Government: Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy to institutionalize energy efficiency in the public sector, by providing equipment that promotes and enhances energy efficiency and conservation practices consistent with the National Energy Efficiency and Conservation Plan and national energy efficiency goals, while also fostering greater awareness and knowledge on energy efficiency technologies;

WHEREAS, the City of Mandaluyong intends to fully cooperate with the DOE to give effect to the commitments, duties, and responsibilities agreed upon and sustainably implement the program in the City of Mandaluyong;

WHEREAS, the DOE, in view of this commitment, sought for the execution of a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the City of Mandaluyong for the said program, delineating the objectives, obligations, institutional coordination mechanisms, funding, terms, and other relevant arrangements to govern the partnership;

WHEREAS, as reviewed by the City Legal Department of Mandaluyong, the Memorandum of Agreement appears to be noble in its purpose, reasonable as to their terms, and is properly crafted in accordance with law;

WHEREAS, for the MOA to be recognized, the Code requires that a Sanggunian Resolution be issued first before the Local Chief Executive may be authorized to sign contracts in representation of the local government unit.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong, in session assembled, RESOLVED, as it hereby RESOLVES, to authorize the Honorable Mayor CARMELITA A. ABALOS to enter into and sign the Memorandum of Agreement and other related agreements with the Department of Energy (DOE) for the implementation of the "Solar Solutions for Government: Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy in Public Buildings" program in the City of Mandaluyong;


RESOLVED FURTHER, that the City Planning and Development Department (CPDD) of the City Government of Mandaluyong shall remain to be the focal body tasked to coordinate with the DOE in the implementation of the project;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the CPDD of the City Government of Mandaluyong shall ensure the compliance of its roles and responsibilities as provided for under the Memorandum of Agreement, as well as the availability of logistical funds to comply with its obligations under the said Agreement;

RESOLVED FINALLY, that copy of this Resolution be furnished to the DOE, CPDD, and other pertinent Departments and Offices.
