RESOLUTION NO. 3682, S-2025

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE COMPOSITION OF THE MANDALUYONG CITY TRICYCLE FRANCHISING AND REGULATORY BOARD (MCTFRB) PURSUANT TO CITY ORDINANCE NO. 743, S-2019, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "OMNIBUS TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT CODE OF THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG"

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", mandates the local government unit to exercise powers essential to the promotion of the general welfare and shall ensure safety, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of its inhabitants, among others;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 granted certain powers to the LGUs through their respective Sangguniang Panlungsod pursuant to Section 458 (3) (vi) thereof, subject to the guidelines prescribed by the Department of Transportation and Communications, through the enactment of ordinances, to regulate the operation of tricycle and grant franchises for the operation thereof within the territorial jurisdiction of the city;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Mandaluyong enacted Ordinance No. 743, S-2019, or the "Omnibus Traffic Management Code of the City of Mandaluyong", regulating tricycle operation in the City as well as the granting of franchise for motorized gasoline-fed and electric tricycles operating within the territorial jurisdiction of Mandaluyong and the subsequent issuance of Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC);

WHEREAS, Section 96 of Ordinance No. 743, S-2019 created the Mandaluyong City Tricycle Franchising & Regulatory Board (MCTFRB) composed of Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Three (3) members, and as may be determined by the Sanggunian by way of adoption of a Resolution, clothed with power to recommend to the Sangguniang Panlungsod qualified tricycle owners, operators and/or applicants for the issuance of franchise and the CPC;

WHEREAS, in furtherance of promoting general welfare and the overriding demand in granting tricycle operation franchise and Certificate of Public Convenience within the City of Mandaluyong, there is a need to adopt the composition of the Mandaluyong City Tricycle Franchising and Regulatory Board (MCTFRB);

WHEREAS, the President of the Mandaluyong Federation of Tricycle Drivers and Operators Association (MAFETA) shall also serve in the Tricycle Franchising Board as a non-voting member.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Mandaluyong, in a session duly assembled, RESOLVED, as it hereby RESOLVES, to ADOPT the composition of the Mandaluyong City Tricycle Franchising and Regulatory Board, thus:

SECTION 1. COMPOSITION. The Mandaluyong CTFRB shall be composed of the following:


SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS. The MCTFRB shall have the following functions:

- a. To accept, screen, evaluate and recommend to the Sangguniang Panlungsod the grant of franchise to qualified tricycle owners or operator/applicants including the determination of the optimum number of tricycle units that should be allowed to operate in any designated area or zone.
- b. To conduct studies on the demands for motorized tricycle-for-hire service on a particular area or zone and submit copies of the same to the City Council for its consideration.
- c. To identify motorized tricycle-for-hire terminals, area or zone in consultation with the concerned Tricycle Operator and Drivers Association, the Federation of Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association, the Barangay officials of the areas affected and the public, taking into consideration existing traffic laws and ordinances and the public's safety and convenience.

SECTION 3. SECRETARIAT. The Members and the Secretariat shall provide secretarial support and assistance and other allied support to the Board.


