RESOLUTION NO. 3684, S-2025

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF MANDALUYONG, THROUGH THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE, HONORABLE CITY MAYOR CARMELITA A. ABALOS TO DONATE THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FIVE MILLION PESOS (₱5,000,000.00), AS FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE EARTHQUAKE-AFFECTED LOCALITIES IN THE PROVINCE OF CEBU WHICH WERE HEAVILY DAMAGED BY THE 6.9 MAGNITUDE EARTHQUAKE ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2025, SPECIFICALLY TO THE CITY OF BOGO AND THE MUNICIPALITIES OF DAANBANTAYAN, BANTAYAN, MADRIDEJOS, SANTA FE, MEDELLIN, TABOGON, TABUELAN, AND SAN REMIGIO, CHARGEABLE AGAINST THE 30% QUICK RESPONSE FUND OUT OF 5% DISASTER RISK REDUCTION MANAGEMENT FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF MANDALUYONG FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2025

WHEREAS, on September 30, 2025, a destructive 6.9 magnitude earthquake struck several towns in the Province of Cebu and nearby areas, causing extensive damage, the tragic loss of lives, numerous injuries, displacement of families, destruction of homes, businesses, and livelihoods;

WHEREAS, the City of Boggo was identified as the hardest-hit, and other nearby municipalities with residents in urgent need of humanitarian aid and rehabilitation support;

WHEREAS, the earthquake left the Province of Cebu under a State of Calamity, requiring immediate assistance from both national and local government units (LGUs) as well as private sector to aid in its rescue, relief, recovery and rehabilitation efforts;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the *Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010*, authorizes local government units to utilize the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF) to provide assistance to other LGUs declared under a state of calamity;

WHEREAS, the Honorable City Mayor Carmelita A. Abalos, through a letter dated October 2, 2025, sought authority from this august body to allocate, transfer and utilize portion of the city's Quick Response Fund Local Disaster Risk Reduction Management Fund in the total amount of Five Million Pesos (₱5,000,000.00) to extend financial assistance to the earthquake-affected localities in the Province of Cebu chargeable against the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF);

WHEREAS, it is the initiative and able leadership of the Honorable Carmelita A. Abalos, with the collective support of the City Council, in her capacity as the City Mayor and Chairperson of the Mandaluyong City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (Mandaluyong CDRRMC), to stand in solidarity with the people of Cebu in this time of great trial, in the *spirit of bayanihan* and inter-local government cooperation;

WHEREAS, the proposed distribution of the financial assistance is as follows:


1. City of Bogo – One Million Pesos (₱1,000,000.00)
2. Municipality of Daanbantayan – Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (₱500,000.00)
3. Municipality of Bantayan – Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (₱500,000.00)
4. Municipality of Madridejos – Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (₱500,000.00)
5. Municipality of Santa Fe – Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (₱500,000.00)
6. Municipality of Medellin – Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (₱500,000.00)
7. Municipality of Tabogon – Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (₱500,000.00)
8. Municipality of Tabuelan – Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (₱500,000.00)
9. Municipality of San Remigio – Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (₱500,000.00)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Mandaluyong, in session duly assembled, to authorize the Honorable City Mayor Carmelita A. Abalos to donate the total amount of Five Million Pesos (₱5,000,000.00), as financial assistance to the earthquake-affected localities in the Province of Cebu which were heavily damaged by the 6.9 magnitude earthquake on September 30, 2025, specifically to the city of Bogo and the Municipalities of Daanbantayan, Bantayan, Madridejos, Santa Fe, Medellin, Tabogon, Tabuelan, and San Remigio, chargeable against the 30% Quick Response Fund out of 5% Disaster Risk Reduction Management Fund of the City Government of Mandaluyong for Calendar Year 2025, subject to applicable accounting and auditing laws, rules and regulations.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copy of this Resolution be furnished to the Office of the Honorable City Mayor, the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Department (CDRRMD), and the concerned recipient LGUs in the Province of Cebu for their information and appropriate action.

ADOPTED on this 3rd day of October 2025, in the City of Mandaluyong.
