RESOLUTION NO. 3687, S-2025

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PRODUCTION
OF BRAILLE MATERIALS TO PROMOTE
ACCESSIBILITY AND INCLUSION FOR PERSONS
WITH VISUAL IMPAIRMENT, WITH THE THEME
“LIGHT AT THE FINGERTIPS”**

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7277, otherwise known as the Magna Carta for Persons with Disability (PWDs), as amended, mandates the State to ensure the rehabilitation, self-development, and integration of persons with disabilities into mainstream society;

WHEREAS, Section 29 of the same Act encourages the accessibility of public information, including documents and reading materials, to persons with visual impairment through the use of braille, large print, and other appropriate formats;

WHEREAS, the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (CRPD), to which the Philippines is a signatory, provides that States shall take appropriate measures to ensure persons with disabilities can access information and communication on an equal basis with others;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Mandaluyong recognizes the right of every individual, regardless of physical condition, to participate meaningfully in community affairs and access essential government information, services, and public facilities;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod has initiated the development and production of government information materials in braille, with the aim of ensuring equal opportunities for persons with visual impairment to benefit from government services and to actively participate in social, cultural, and civic activities;

WHEREAS, to further promote inclusivity and empowerment of persons who are blind or visually impaired, the City Government finds it necessary to adopt a Braille Accessibility Program, which shall include the translation of key public documents, informational materials, and signages in Braille format;

WHEREAS, this initiative also seeks to raise public awareness on the importance of accessibility, promote inclusivity, and encourage other local government units to adopt similar measures for the empowerment of PWDs;

WHEREAS, the production of braille materials will not only address the information gap but will also enhance the confidence, independence, and active involvement of visually impaired constituents in the affairs of the community, thereby fostering a stronger sense of belonging and equality;

WHEREAS, braille is a vital tool in ensuring that visually impaired individuals are able to read, learn, and fully engage with their environment;


WHEREAS, this initiative aligns with the City's continuing commitment to make Mandaluyong a disability-inclusive and people-centered City, ensuring that no sector is left behind.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF MANDALUYONG CITY, in session assembled, to adopt the implementation of the Braille Accessibility Program in the City of Mandaluyong to promote inclusivity and access to information for persons with visual impairment and other related disabilities.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to the City Social Welfare and Development (CSWD), the Persons with Disabilities Affairs Division (PDAD) and the Department of Education (DepEd) Schools Division, for their information and support.


