**RESOLUTION NO. 3690, S-2025**

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR CARMELITA A. ABALOS TO GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE FIFTEEN (15) FAMILY RESIDENTS CONSISTING OF ELEVEN (11) STRUCTURE OWNERS, ONE (1) SHARER AND THREE (3) RENTERS AFFECTED BY DEVELOPMENT AND CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD NETWORKS OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT LOCATED AT BLOCK 32 EXTENSION, BLOCK 10 AND BLOCK 29 OF THE WELFAREVILLE COMPOUND, BARANGAY ADDITION HILLS, MANDALUYONG CITY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991, under the General Welfare Clause, local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessary implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare, and shall ensure and support, among other things, to enhance economic prosperity and social justice, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, in furtherance of its mandate to provide basic services and facilities, the City Government of Mandaluyong, as it deemed necessary, appropriate and incidental to the efficient and effective provisions of infrastructure facility to service the needs of the residents of the City, endeavored to develop and construct road networks within the Welfareville Compound in Barangay Addition Hills;

WHEREAS, in the construction of road network in the above-mentioned areas, it was determined, through the information provided by the Honorable Barangay Chairman of Addition Hills, Carlito T. Cernal, and as attested to by the Officer-in-Charge of Welfareville Commission affected by the road widening efforts of the City;

WHEREAS, while the City Government of Mandaluyong acknowledges its duty in providing basic facilities and to serve the public purpose in providing accessible roads to its constituents, the City also recognizes that it has social responsibility in promoting social justice to the families affected and displaced by the proposed government road construction, necessitating the need for assistance;

WHEREAS, the City Mayor, Honorable Carmelita A. Abalos, to temporarily aid and alleviate the hardship of the affected residents displaced by reason of the construction of road networks and upon the recommendation of the Honorable Barangay Addition Hills Chairman, Carlito T. Cernal, and OIC of WELCOMM, Mr. Gerundio A. Blanco, seeks to grant financial assistance to the affected families amounting to Fifteen Thousand Pesos (Php15,000.00) per structure OWNER/family (11 families identified structure owners), and Eight Thousand Pesos (Php8,000.00) per RENTER/family (3 families identified renters) and One (1) SHARER, with the total amount of One Hundred Ninety Seven Thousand Pesos (Php197,000.00) and shall be chargeable to the Mandaluyong Housing Development Department (MHDD) – Demolition and Relocation Expenses for CY 2025, as affirmed by the MHDD Head, Atty. Sherwin SJ Enriquez, and certified by the City Treasurer and City Accountant for the availability of funds, subject to accounting, and auditing laws, rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, the grant of financial assistance to the affected families deserves consideration of this Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong in accord with its mandate under the Local Government Code in promoting the welfare of its constituents as a measure of social justice.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong, in session assembled, RESOLVED, as it hereby RESOLVES, to grant financial assistance to the Fifteen (15) Family Residents consisting of Eleven (11) Structure Owners in the amount of ₱15,000.00 each and ₱8,000.00 each for One (1) Sharer and Three (3) Renters affected by development and construction of road networks of the City Government located at Block 32 Extension, Block 10 and Block 29 of the Welfareville Compound, Barangay Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that copy of this Resolution be furnished to the Honorable City Mayor Carmelita A. Abalos at the Office of the Mayor, Mandaluyong Housing and Development Department, City Planning and Development Department, City Engineering Department, Urban Poor Affairs Office, City Accounting Department, City Budget Department, Office of the Chairman, Barangay Addition Hills, City Budget Department, City Treasury Department, City Accounting Department, and other concerned departments or offices.


