RESOLUTION NO. 3691, S-2025

A RESOLUTION OF COMMENDATION TO THE FIVE (5) TRAFFIC ENFORCERS GUILLERMO D. NERIA, ARNEL D. MONES, ORLANDO O. DALISAY, MICHAEL G. TAMONDONG, AND ERWIN A. CORONADO OF THE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DIVISION FOR THEIR HEROIC ACT AND DEDICATION TO THEIR DUTY IN APPREHENDING A SUSPECT ENGAGED IN THEFT OF GOVERNMENT PROPERTY, (ELECTRICAL WIRES, CABLES, AND LIGHT BULBS) ALONG BONI AVENUE AND THEREBY ENSURING PUBLIC SAFETY AND UPHOLDING THE RULE OF LAW

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that every local government unit shall exercise the power necessary and appropriate for the promotion of the general welfare, including the preservation of peace and order, and the protection of life, liberty, and property;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Mandaluyong, through the Sangguniang Panlungsod, recognizes acts of bravery, vigilance, and integrity among its personnel who demonstrate extraordinary commitment in the performance of their duties to ensure public safety and protect government property;

WHEREAS, on October 14, 2025, at around 2:45 in the afternoon, Traffic Enforcers Michael G. Tamondong, Guillermo D. Neria, Arnel D. Mones, Orlando O. Dalisay, and Erwin A. Coronado, assigned along Lions Road, Barangay Ilaya, Mandaluyong City, were performing their regular duties when they were alerted by a concerned citizen about individuals allegedly stealing electrical wires and light bulbs installed along the pedestrian tunnel along Boni Avenue;

WHEREAS, responding swiftly to the report, the said enforcers immediately responded and proceeded to the scene, where they discovered several suspects actively removing electrical cables and lighting fixtures installed along the pedestrian tunnel;

WHEREAS, demonstrating teamwork and quick judgment, the traffic enforcers pursued and successfully apprehended one of the suspects identified as John Christopher Serrano y Ocampo, 35 years old, resident of Barangay Old Zaniga, Mandaluyong City, found in possession of the stolen electrical materials;

WHEREAS, following standard procedure, the enforcers the enforcers promptly brought him to the Mandaluyong City Medical Center for medical examination and subsequently turned him over to the Mandaluyong City Police Station for proper filing of theft charges pursuant to the provisions of the Revised Penal Code (Article 308 - Theft);

WHEREAS, the enforcers' composure, respect for due process, and adherence to lawful procedure embody the principles of professionalism, accountability, and public service as mandated under Republic Act No. 6713, or the Code of Conduct and Ethical Standards for Public Officials and Employees exemplifying the kind of public service that brings pride and honor to the City Government of Mandaluyong;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Mandaluyong upholds and values acts of bravery, integrity, and vigilance among its personnel, especially those who go beyond the call of duty to safeguard the welfare and security of its citizens;

WHEREAS, the Division Head of the Traffic Enforcement Division, Ms. Lorie L. Lumabas, has formally endorsed these traffic enforcers for commendation in recognition of their heroic act, exemplary performance, and dedication to public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded by the Sangguniang Panlungsod, RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED,, commending the five (5) Traffic Enforcers Guillermo D. Neria, Arnel D. Mones, Orlando O. Dalisay, Michael G. Tamondong, and Erwin A. Coronado of the Traffic Enforcement Division for their heroic act and dedication to their duty in apprehending a suspect engaged in theft of government property, (electrical wires, cables, and light bulbs) along Boni Avenue and thereby ensuring public safety and upholding the rule of law.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to each of the commended traffic enforcers, the Office of the City Mayor, and the Traffic Enforcement Division for their information, record, and appropriate recognition.

ADOPTED on this 20th day of October 2025, in the City of Mandaluyong.


