RESOLUTION NO. 3693, S-2025

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING DEEPEST CONDOLENCES AND PAYING TRIBUTE TO THE LATE ATTY. GERARDO B. ROLDAN JR., FORMER MEMBER OF THE FIRST MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF MANDALUYONG (1988–1992), AND EXTENDING PRAYERS OF SOLACE TO HIS FAMILY AND LOVED ONES

WHEREAS, it is with profound sadness that the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong learned of the passing of Atty. Gerardo B. Roldan, Jr. on October 11, 2025, at the age of eighty-three (83), a respected lawyer and former member of the First Municipal Council of Mandaluyong (1988–1992);

WHEREAS, Atty. Roldan was among those recognized by the City Government for his valuable service as a pioneering member of the First Municipal Council, as cited in the official recognition given on April 23, 2024;

WHEREAS, during his tenure as Municipal Councilor, Atty. Roldan served with integrity, dedication, and vision, authoring and co-authoring several legislative measures that continue to benefit the residents of Mandaluyong to this day;

WHEREAS, he was, likewise, among the authors and proponents of the legislative measures that paved the way for the conversion of Mandaluyong from a municipality into a highly urbanized city, marking a significant milestone in the City's history and progress;

WHEREAS, among the notable ordinances and resolutions he sponsored or co-sponsored are:

- **Ordinance creating the Garbage Disposal System of the Municipality**, establishing environmental discipline and sanitation practices;
- **Ordinance activating the Mandaluyong Anti-Drug Abuse Council (MADAC)**, which remains instrumental in the City's anti-drug campaign;
- **Ordinance amending regulations on the use of public streets, sidewalks, and other public spaces**, promoting order and accessibility;
- **Ordinance prohibiting unauthorized long-distance use of government telephone facilities**, ensuring fiscal discipline in the use of public resources;
- **Ordinance amending requirements for Mayor's Permit applications and renewals**, improving transparency and compliance in business operations;
- **Ordinance regulating amusement and entertainment establishments in the municipality**, fostering community welfare and safety; and
- **Ordinance imposing transfer fees on real property transactions**, which became a continuing local revenue measure;

WHEREAS, Atty. Roldan was also principal author and co-author of several significant resolutions, including measures on urban development, housing projects, road construction, and social services, as well as resolutions honoring exemplary citizens and promoting community welfare, demonstrating his commitment to progressive governance;

WHEREAS, beyond his legislative service, Atty. Roldan continued to practice law with the same sense of duty and fairness that defined his public service, upholding the principles of justice and good governance through his work at the Roldan Tabobo Cortesa Law Office;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong desires to honor his lifelong service to the City and the community, and to extend its heartfelt sympathy to his bereaved family;



ADOPTED on this 20th day of October 2025, in the City of Mandaluyong.


